In line with the aspirations of the first National Policy on Inclusive Volunteering 2020 to 2024 approved by the Federal Executive Council (FEC) under the leadership of President Mohammadu Buhari, GCFR in December, 2020, the Nigerian Youth Volunteers (NYV) collaborates with the National Orientation Agency (NOA) to facilitate the effective implementation of the National Youth Development Programme (NYVDP).

The Policy objectives and strategic aspiration of the National Policy on Inclusive Volunteering is to leverage the instrumentality of Volunteerism to mobilise both Human and Material Resources to support development efforts through volunteering and community service and to leverage the power of Volunteering to harness, positively engage and nurture the grossly redundant demographic resources of the Nigerian Youth.

The National Youth Volunteer Development Programme is an equal opportunity and incentive-based positive youth engagement and development programme through innovative volunteer programming. To achieve the strategic objective of lifelong and service learning aimed at changing the mindset and reorientation of the youth, youth aspiring to participate in the National Youth Volunteer Development Programme are required to undergo a compulsory Citizenship and Leadership Training at the Citizenship and Leadership Training Centres across the Country before enrolment into the various components of the programme of their choice.

In line with the provisions of the National Policy on Inclusive Volunteering, all participating youth volunteers are required to sign-up for a Volunteer Group Life Insurance Policy.

Programme Funding Options

The National Youth Volunteer Development Programme is designed to leverage innovative crowdfunding, fundraising, donations and grants to raise funds to support the implementation of programmes for the benefits of the Nigerian Youth Volunteers under the auspices of the Nigerian Youth Volunteer Development Trust Fund.

Guided by the aspirations of the National Policy on Inclusive Volunteering and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), the Programmes of the National Youth Volunteer Development are designed to respond to the core principle of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) as it relates to **People**, **Planet**, **Prosperity**, **Peace and Partnership**.
